AP (Associated Press) Images – User Name: nbwvikings **Password:** nbwvikings

Provides images and graphics that can be used in papers and multimedia presentations. Material is updated daily.

BadgerLink – No username or password needed, but if you are trying to access from home you will need your public library card number.

Provides access to online information resources for Wisconsin residents. Within BadgerLink there are a variety of databases to search from including EBSCOhost, Auto Repair Reference Center, and Literary Reference Center.

Biography Resource Center – Password: nbwvikings

A biographical online reference database containing more than 435,000 biographies on more than 340,000 people.

Culture Grams – User Name: nbwvikings **Password:** nbwvikings

Includes a World, States, and Kids edition. Use this reference to find reliable and up-to-date information on states and countries.

Discovery Education Streaming (formerly known as United Streaming) –

User Name: nbstudents **Password:** nbstudents

A database that includes videos, audio, and images. Each video has been indexed (or broken into chapters), which gives users the option of viewing the entire program or watching a short clip.

Global Issues in Context – Password: nbwvikings

Offers global news and perspectives on issues and events of international importance and provides background information on the issues.

History Resource Center: U.S. – Password: nbwvikings

Provides a complete overview of U.S. history and covers the most studied events, issues, and current information using both primary and secondary sources.

History Resource Center: World – Password: nbwvikings

Use this database to access primary and secondary sources related to world history.

Magill's Medical Guide Online – Password: nbwvikings

Covers diseases, disorders, treatments, procedures, specialties, anatomy, biology, and other medical issues

SIRS Researcher – User Name: nbwvikings **Password:** nbwvikings

A general reference database with full-text articles on social, scientific, health, historic, business, economic, political and global issues. Graphics, including charts, maps, diagrams and drawings, are available for many of the articles. SIRS is good to use for finding pro/con information.

Soundzabound – No username or password needed for school use. Home use: **User Name:** nbps **Password:** nbps

Royalty free music to use in presentations, movies, and other multimedia projects.

Teen Health and Wellness – User Name: nbwvikings **Password:** nbwvikings

Provides information for teens on diseases, drugs, alcohol, nutrition, fitness, mental health, diversity, family life, and more.

Virtual Reference Library – Password: nbwvikings

Reference books in a database format. Subjects covered include: the arts, biographies, business, education, environment, history, law, literature, medicine, multicultural studies, nation and world, religion, science, and social studies.

Provides students with career and post-secondary school information. Students are able to create a profile and portfolio that will stay with them throughout their time at West.
